

New Frontiers in CKD Treatment: Truly Portable Dialysis

Join BAAKP at 3 pm on September 7, 2025, for Part 2 of our series on New Frontiers in CKD Treatment. This webinar features Dr. Buddy Ratner, a Professor of Bioengineering at the University of Washington, whose team has built a prototype portable dialysis machine. This machine is housed in a suitcase that fits in an airplane overhead compartment. It has two startling innovations:

- It needs only 2 liters of water for each treatment (vs. 400 liters for conventional dialysis); and
- It is safe and needle-free!

Dr. Ratner will comment on how this revolutionary device builds on the history of dialysis innovation at UW, how it works, and where it is on its path to commercial availability.
